Slime

²∕₃ cup glue

½ t. baking soda

- 1.5 T contact lens solution (must contain boric acid and sodium borate)
- 2-3 cups shaving cream

Food coloring (optional)

- 1. In a large bowl, mix glue and baking soda.
- 2. Gradually stir in contact lens solution. As slime comes together, switch to kneading with hands. If the slime is sticky, squirt a little more contact solution (too much will make it stiff).
- 3. Knead in 2-3 cups of shaving cream.
- 4. If desired, add food coloring, starting with a few drops. You may need to add a lot to get the color you want.
- 5. Store slime in an airtight container. Slime will deflate the next day, but still work great.
