We at Hearts & Hands Christian Preschool want you to know that we value the safety and wellbeing of you and your child(ren). For this reason, we ask that you take time to read through the following statements that we have put into place to keep everyone healthy and safe:

- Morning Drop-off
 - Drop-off - Staff will pick-up your child at your vehicle for morning drop-off.
 - 2.5's class should park near the church office entrance in a parking spot
 - 3's & 4's class should line up with the first vehicle starting at the classroom entrance and the rest lined up behind.
- Pick-up after class
 - Pick-up will be at the playground.
- While indoors, shoes are OPTIONAL for staff and children.
- If **you** need to enter the program for any reason, before entering you will need to:
 - fill out health screening questionnaire,
 - wash or sanitize your hands upon entry.
- If your child becomes ill while in our program, you will be asked to pick-up your child within one hour of the program contacting you. Please have plans in place to ensure you or a designated person is available if this should occur.
- We will be spending a lot of time outdoors. If desired, please apply sunscreen/bug spray before coming to school as we are not able to supply or apply these items. Sending a hat for sun protection is also a good idea. Bring rain gear if rain is predicted. We continue to go outside when the weather gets colder, please bring appropriate clothing when that occurs as well.
- Health Policy – please read through the health policy and agree to follow it before sending your child to school. Note that masks are optional in the classroom for all.
- We use the Brightwheel app which has questions to answer daily at drop-off:
 - Child does not have any COVID symptoms currently or in the past 24 hours
 - Temperature was below 100.4 this morning. (Please take your child's temperature before coming to school as we will not be taking daily temperatures.)
 - Have not taken fever-reducing medications this morning
